

**Articulation Agreement between
SUNY Corning Community College & GST BOCES
September 2026 – June 2031
Professional Business and Financial Technology Curriculum**

Purpose and Intent

Based upon the mutual concern of both SUNY Corning Community College (CCC) and the GST BOCES to provide students a continuous, articulated academic program in Business and Financial Management while developing in-demand skills, the following are agreements to which we mutually subscribe.

Provisions and Particulars

Students who have fulfilled the learning outcomes defined in the GST Professional Business and Financial Technology curriculum will receive credit for the following CCC courses- each of these courses is 3 credits, for a total award of 9 credits:

SPCH 1080 Public Speaking

BUSN 1030 Business Communications

BUSN 1060 Customer Service and Relationship Management

This curriculum satisfies 9 credits towards program requirements in the Accounting/Financial Management AS degree, Business AS degree and Business AAS degree. These credits can also be applied as Humanities and free elective credit in a variety of programs at CCC.


To earn the SUNY CCC credits, students must pass each course in the Professional Business and Financial Technology curriculum with a B (80 average) or higher. The BOCES transcript should be submitted by the student upon application to CCC. Students must be matriculated in an academic program at CCC in order to receive this credit.

Changes in curriculum at either institution will be transmitted to the other as any occur. This agreement will be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years with a signed agreement by the participating parties or when a change of instructors or curriculum occurs at either institution that would affect the validity of the agreement.
