

**Articulation Agreement for Early Childhood Education  
between  
SUNY Corning Community College & Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES  
2024-2029**

**Purpose and Intent**

Based upon the mutual concern of both the Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES and SUNY Corning Community College (CCC) to provide a continuous articulated academic program in **Early Childhood Education**, one that builds on past learning experience and eliminates duplication of instruction, the following are agreements to which we mutually subscribe.

**Provisions and Particulars**

Students who have fulfilled the learning outcomes defined in the GST BOCES Early Childhood Education program, and receiving an overall program average of B (80) or higher, may receive credit for the following course:

ECED 1140: Methods & Materials in Early Childhood Education          (3 Credit Hours)

Eligible students...

1. Must meet all college admissions requirements
2. Must be highly recommended in a letter submitted by a certified Early Childhood Education teacher from the BOCES program.

Upon review and acceptance of the BOCES transcript and letter of recommendation, the Associate Dean of Instruction (ADI) of the Liberal Arts and Professional Studies division and the full-time Education faculty member will communicate this credit to the Office of the Registrar at SUNY CCC.

SUNY Corning Community College will be allowed the opportunity to observe all the instructors who teach classes that could be transferred to Corning Community College.

The SUNY CCC transcripts of students completing this agreement will bear credit notations indicating the successful completion of these program requirements, but not grades, as per College policy.

Changes in curriculum at either institution will be transmitted to the other as any occur. This agreement will be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years with a signed agreement by the participating parties or when a change of instructors or curriculum occurs at either institution that would affect the validity of the agreement.




