

Articulation Agreement
between
Corning Community College & Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES

Purpose and Intent

Based upon the mutual concern of both the Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES and Corning Community College (CCC) to provide a continuous articulated academic program in **CISCO Networking Academy**, one that builds on past learning experience and eliminates duplication of instruction, the following are agreements to which we mutually subscribe.

Provisions and Particulars

Students who have fulfilled the learning outcomes defined in the GST BOCES CISCO Networking Academy program, within 14 months prior to matriculating into the Information Technology program at CCC, may receive 4 credit hours through the Credit for Prior Learning process (formally known as Career Pathways). The four (4) credit hours consist of the following course:

Name of Course/s	(Number of Credit Hours)
CSNT1200 - Introduction to Networks	4

Eligible students ...

1. Must meet all college admissions requirements.
2. Must be highly recommended by a certified CISCO Networking Academy instructor.
3. Must have completed the CISCO Networking Academy Program with an average of 85% or better.
4. Must have received their High School diploma within 14 months of application for this credit, or at the discretion of the CCC program director
5. Must complete the Assessment of Prior Learning document (course proficiency profile) and submit all necessary documentation to the Chair of Technology, Engineering & Computing at CCC.
6. Must be eligible to take College Composition I (ENGL 1010) by placement.
7. Must be eligible to take MATH1230 (or higher) by placement

Upon review and acceptance of these materials, the Chair of Technology, Engineering & Computing at Corning Community College will provide the agreed upon credits or waivers. A fee per credit hour will be required for this credit providing the student follows all appropriate processes as outlined. The fee will be the current portfolio credit for prior learning fee required by Corning Community College.

Corning Community College will be allowed the opportunity to observe all the instructors who teach classes that could be transferred to Corning Community College.

The transcripts of students completing this agreement will bear credit notations indicating the successful completion of these program requirements, but not grades, as per college policy.

Effective Date and Provision for Cancellation

This agreement becomes effective on the latest date of signature on the agreement signature page and shall remain in effect until either party requests a change.

The College shall provide information to the secondary school on the academic progress of matriculated students when requested.
