

**Articulation Agreement
between
SUNY Corning Community College & Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES
(Coopers Campus, Wildwood Campus, and Bush Campus)
2024-2029**

Purpose and Intent:

Based upon the mutual concern of both the Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES and SUNY Corning Community College (CCC) to provide a continuous articulated academic program in Cosmetology, via the Business Administration AAS degree, one that builds on past learning experience and eliminates duplication of instruction, the following are agreements to which we mutually subscribe.

Provisions and Particulars:

Students who have fulfilled the learning outcomes defined in the GST BOCES Cosmetology program with an overall program GPA of C (70) or higher may receive 6 credit hours through the Credit for Prior learning Articulated Credit process. The six (6) credit hours consists of the following courses:

Professionalism – BUSN 1055 (3 Credit Hours)
Customer Service & Relationship Management – BUSN 1060 (3 Credit Hours)

BUSN 1055 is a program requirement for the Business AAS degree at SUNY CCC; BUSN 1060 will be applied to the program electives within the same degree.

Eligible students...

- (1) **Must** meet all college admissions requirements.
- (2) **Must** submit their transcript to the Associate Dean of Instruction of the Liberal Arts and Professional Studies Division verifying completion of the Cosmetology program with an overall average of C (70) or higher.

Upon review and acceptance of these materials, the Associate Dean of Instruction of the Liberal Arts and Professional Studies Division at SUNY Corning Community College will provide the agreed upon credits.


The transcripts of students completing this agreement will bear credit notations indicating the successful completion of these program requirements, but not grades, as per college policy.



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
