

**Articulation Agreement for Nurse Education AAS program
between
SUNY Corning Community College & Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES
September 2024 – June 2029**

Purpose and Intent

Based upon the mutual concern of both SUNY Corning Community College (CCC) and the Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES to provide a continuous, articulated academic program in Nurse Education, and a pathway that provides students the opportunity to develop the skills needed to meet the urgent need for registered nurses in our community, the following are agreements to which we mutually subscribe:

Provisions and Particulars

Students who have fulfilled the learning outcomes defined in the GST BOCES Nursing Assisting program will receive the following benefits:

- a. For students entering the Community and Public Health Education (CPHE): Allied Health AS degree to complete prerequisites for the Nurse Education program- provided the student earns a final grade of C or higher, the Nursing Assisting curriculum can satisfy 3 credits of a Health elective in the CPHE program
- b. For students who have either completed the prerequisites within the CPHE program or for those who are applying directly into the Nurse Education program from the Nursing Assisting program- the following points will be added to the student's admissions rubric; please note the admissions process is based on a points system. The grades listed below are the final average in the Nursing Assisting program.

A (90 and above): 5 points

B (80 and above): 4 points

C (70 and above): 3 points

No points will be awarded for grades of D (69 or below) or lower.

All other admissions requirements must be fulfilled by the GST BOCES Nursing Assisting graduates.

This agreement will be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years with a signed agreement by the participating parties or when a change of instructors or curriculum occurs at either institution that would affect the validity of the agreement.
