

## 2024-2025 Direct Unsubsidized Loan Only

The Financial Aid Office has received your 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You'll see that "Yes" is selected as the answer to the "Direct Unsubsidized Loan Only" question. Change your answer to the "Direct Unsubsidized Loan Only" question to "No." Then, select **"Continue"** to navigate through the rest of the form and invite your parent(s).
